DUAL ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT
CHIPOLA COLLEGE**

Chipola College's Dual Enrollment program provides the opportunity for qualified home school, private school and Virtual High School students who reside in Calhoun, Holmes, Jackson, Liberty, and Washington Counties. Students must meet the eligibility criteria specified by Chipola College and the Florida statutes for home school students to enroll in college courses while simultaneously enrolled in home school, private school, or Virtual High School Program. Students receive both high school and college credit for these courses. Dual Enrollment students are exempt from tuition, matriculation, and laboratory fees. Students will be responsible for textbooks and supplies.

- Workforce Development – Passed the Reading subtest of the ACT, CPT, or SAT. Student must also meet required scores for chosen program of study.

Early Admission Program

- Academic Program – Passed all subtest of the ACT, CPT, or SAT.
- Workforce Development Program – Passed the Reading subtest of the ACT, CPT, or SAT.
