Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access, limited enrollment program.

A minimum composite score of 20 on the Enhanced ACT and a minimum GPA of 2.5 are required for admission to the College of Education. Strong academic preparation is a must! October 15 deadline for Spring term; March 15 deadline for Fall term. All application materials must be filed by the deadline date, not in the mail!

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrated by the FSU Computer Science department. Students may take CGS 1060 at CJC to satisfy this requirement.

Applicants are chosen based on GPA, ACT/SAT scores, relevant experience, and professional promise. Contact FSU College of Education, Stone Bldg., Tallahassee, FL, (850-644-5458), for a complete application packet.

Applicants must complete a self-disclosure form that requires them to respond to any personal criminal background information; they must be fingerprinted before student teaching in certain counties.
