

This Associate of Arts degree program is designed for students who expect to transfer and earn a degree in Political Science at the University of Florida.

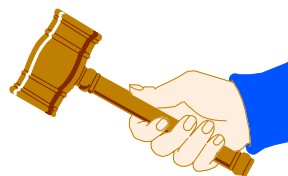
