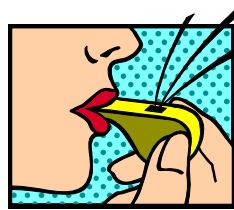

Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

This major is in the College of Education which requires a minimum 2.5 GPA, a minimum score of 20 on the enhanced ACT, and passing scores on all parts of the CLAST for admission.

FSU requires basic computer proficiency. Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. Students may take CGS 1060 at CJC to satisfy this requirement.
