### Entrance Requirements

All entering music majors are required to take a placement audition in applied music. Students are expected to be prepared to play or sing representative works. Work closely with your advisor to schedule specific courses for your major.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT.

FSU requires competency in oral communications for graduation. If students took a speech course in high school or were members of a debate team, they may exempt this requirement. If not, students should take SPC 2600 at Chipola to satisfy this requirement.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. CGS 1060, CGS 1100, or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.
