Entrance Requirements

This is a limited access program.

A strong academic preparation is a must. While a minimum 2.5 GPA is required for admission to the College of Education, to be competitive a 3.0 or higher GPA is recommended. This requirement may change. The student should assume responsibility for checking with UWF for all admissions requirements to Teacher Education.

As a part of the admissions process, the College of Education requires that all students be fingerprinted and pass an FBI and FDLE background check.

UWF requires all students to pass the Florida Teacher Certification Exam before the bachelor's degree is awarded.

If a student has completed two years of high school credit in the same foreign language, he/she meets the admission requirement for state universities in Florida. If not, the student should complete two semesters of the same foreign language at Chipola before transfer to the university.
