### Entrance Requirements

A minimum overall GPA of 2.5, passing scores on all parts of CLAST, and a minimum GPA of 3.0 in art/art history classes are required for admission into Art Education.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. CGS 1060, CGS 1100, or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

Applicants must complete a self-disclosure form that requires them to respond to any personal criminal background information; they may also be fingerprinted before student teaching in certain counties.
