### Entrance Requirements

A GPA of 3.0 is required for admission.

Theatre is a synthesis of many arts. At FSU a student may choose to study theatre as a part of a broad liberal arts education through the B.A. program or choose to intensively study a particular area through one of the B.F.A. degree programs. Areas of emphasis for the B.F.A. degree are: Acting, Design/Technology and Music Theatre. The Bachelor of Arts degree (B.A.) is a flexible, broad-based liberal arts degree providing basic knowledge of theatre arts.

FSU WILL DENY ADMISSION TO ANY STUDENT WHO HAS NOT SATISFIED THE STATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT. An additional 4 hours of foreign language at the sophomore level will be required for graduation from FSU.

FSU requires basic [computer proficiency](#). Students must demonstrate email, Internet, word processing, & spreadsheet skills; demonstrations are monitored by the FSU Computer Science department. CGS 1060, CGS 1100, or EME 2040 will satisfy this requirement.

The Chipola courses which will meet both this requirement and a general education social sciences requirement include GEA 2001, GEA 2002, REL 2300, SYG 1010, WOH 2012, and WOH 2022. It is strongly recommended that one of these courses be completed before earning the AA degree.

<sup>2</sup> Theatre courses should include areas such as performance production, introduction to theatre, dramatic literature, technical theatre lab, rehearsal and performance, and stagecraft.
