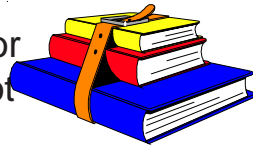


This Associate in Arts (AA) degree program has been designed for students who have not selected a major or have not decided on which college or university they will attend after earning the AA degree.

Entrance Requirements

All colleges and universities in Florida require that you successfully complete two years of the same foreign language in high school or two semesters of the same foreign language at the college level before the baccalaureate degree is awarded. FSU and UF will not admit you unless the foreign language requirement is complete. Currently all other colleges and universities in Florida will admit you without the foreign language courses; however, you will be required to complete them before you graduate with the baccalaureate degree.
