Testing: As per FL. Rule 6A-10.040, students enrolled in a postsecondary program offered for career education credit of 450 hours or more shall complete the entry-level basic skills examination (TABE) within the first six weeks after admission into the program or meet the exemptions as stated in the Chipola Catalog. Students with a passing grade on ENC 1101, passing Reading & Math scores on the ACT, SAT or the PERT within the last two years are not required to take the TABE.

- 1. Age: 18 or meet dual enrollment criteria
- 2. A high school diploma or GED is required for employment in many cases.
