Testing: As per FL. Rule 6A-10.040, students enrolled in a postsecondary program offered for career education credit of 450 hours or more shall complete the entry-level basic skills examination (TABE) within the first six weeks after admission into the program or meet the exemptions as stated in the Chipola Catalog. See an advisor for information.

Students with a passing grade on ENC 1101, passing Reading & Math scores on the ACT, SAT or the PERT within the last two years are not required to take the TABE.

- 1. Age: 18 or meet dual enrollment criteria
- 2. A high school diploma or GED is required for employment in many cases.
- 3. Program hours: Full time day students 7:30 to 3:30 Monday Thursday (Night classes are offered by special appointment for advanced training.)
